Year 8 students took part in a Guess the Job Morning, where they met a number of different employers and had to guess what job they did. They learned about a customer care role at Halton Housing Trust and a range of different creative and scientific roles, including an artist who designed the Eurovision Key and Taylor Swift sculptures in Liverpool.

Foods from around the world 7SA students worked in small groups to write a list of foods they think are produced in a country outside the UK. Students wrote down which country they thought these foods came from. Students discussed their ideas and explained why they thought these foods were produced outside the UK.
