9JO have demonstrated fire circle safety and worked well with others by taking responsibility for completing their tasks in their Forest School lessons.

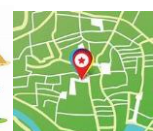
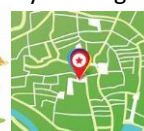
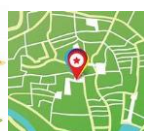
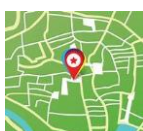
Lastly, we hope you all have a relaxing half-term, spending quality time with your families. We will welcome students back on Monday, June 2nd, 2025.
