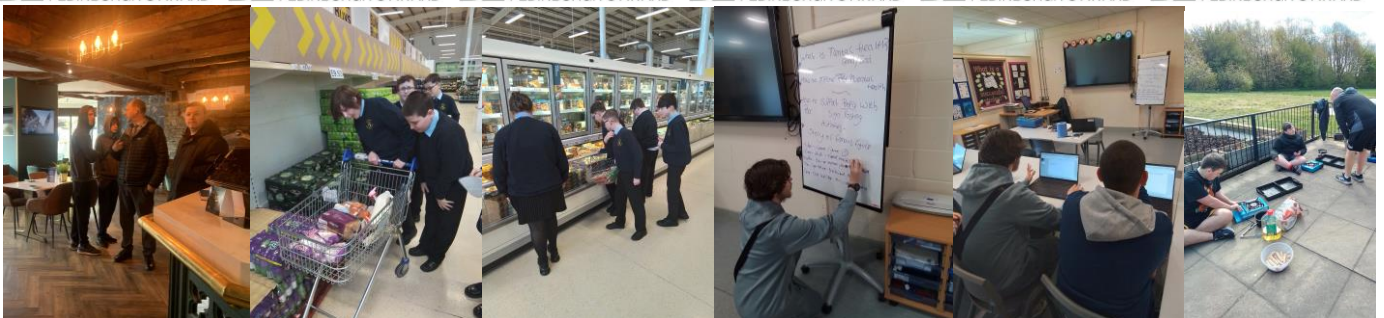
### Ashley Action!
