Ashley Action!

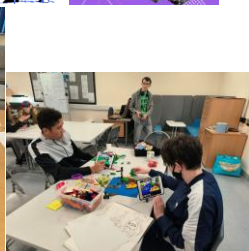
7SA Maths Students have been practicing measuring as part of their maths lessons. Students practised using rulers before measuring the lengths of different things.
