Students use cards or boards containing search terms and as the facilitator calls out Boolean search queries, players mark off relevant terms, aiming to get a bingo. The goal is to help users understand how to construct more effective search strings to find specific information.

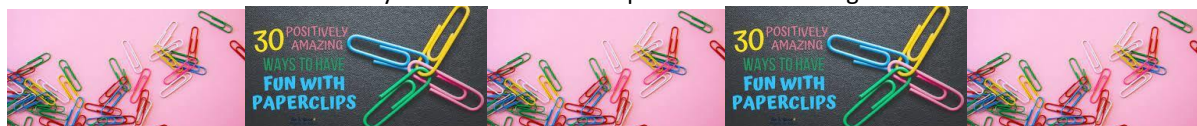
