

In their Food Technology lesson, Year 10 students Archie and Rohan prepared some delectable Samosas. They gained knowledge of the various seasonings and spices used in Indian cooking as well as how to fold samosas.

They used food colouring with both hot and cold water to see how long it took for the food colouring particles to diffuse and move into the water.
