Students celebrated Green Careers Week. The aim of Green Careers is to promote any career that helps to protect and restore the planet. Classes participated with a treasure hunt, which involved visiting the website and researching questions to guide students around the site, which gave them a great overview of what is on offer.

6th Form Students had a visit from CEASE - Remedi to discuss what is a healthy relationship. CEASE is a 4 session educational programme, which aims to: Help young people recognise the subtle indications of an abusive relationship, gain an understanding of the options available to them should they encounter or witness such behaviour, identify local sources of socialist support and support access to those services and create empowerment and self-efficacy.

School Council Students discussed ideas for fundraising within school. Ideas included non-uniform, a cake sale, car boot/market sale, 'sponge the teacher', a school play and a sponsored walk.
